# Family Fun 1

## Make a Blueprint!

Cover a wall with a large piece of paper, gather all the blue crayons, markers, and colored pencils you have and draw on the paper as a family.

## Build on it

Select a favorite Bible story or passage, and let everyone contribute to drawing a picture about it. Let everyone draw his favorite part, or assign sections and create a comic strip to tell the whole story.

### Build on it

Take time beforehand to talk about what the Bible says about serving others (Galatians 5:13-14) and afterwards to talk about what you learned.

This is a game kids may have played at VBS. Use it as a chance to talk about everyone's favorite moments from VBS and what they learned about God through VBS.
